Dear Parent/ Carer,

As part of our 50 Year celebrations, the staff and children have been working hard to produce a musical extravaganza – ‘*West Winds through the Ages*’! Classes have been learning songs and perfecting their drama and dance moves in order to transport you back through the last 50 years, to when West Winds Primary opened in 1972. After a number of years without any shows, we’re delighted to be able to present this to you, in celebration of the decades that the school has lived through.

Please see the following information concerning tickets and arrangements for the week of the show.

- The show will be performed on two occasions: **Wednesday 6th April (10.00am)** and **Thursday 7th April (6.30pm)**. Please note that Nursery will only take part on the Wednesday morning performance. Nursery parents will be allocated Wednesday morning tickets (initially 2 per child) – Miss Ferris will be in touch about this.
- Tickets for the show will cost **£4 for adults** and **£2 for children**. Money raised by the performances will go towards supporting our school fund and our Double Decker Bus library project.
- Tickets will be on sale from **Monday 28th March** – they will be on sale each day that week at **8.45am, 1.45pm and 2.45pm**. Tickets can be purchased from staff at the front of the school. **Please purchase tickets here, rather than sending orders in for class teachers to deal with.**
- There will be an interval during each performance – refreshments will be available to buy

Covid19 Precautions

As such, we are introducing mitigating measures in line with PHA guidance on indoor gatherings in non-domestic settings. Friday 8 th	Last day of term before Easter holidays. This will be a non-uniform day. School will finish for all children at 12.15pm No school meals will be served.
